

ADMISSION PROCEDURE & GUIDELINES

BACHELORS OF PHYSIOTHERAPY

Applies to candidates seeking first-year B.P.T in Karnataka (government and RGUHS-affiliated private colleges).

1) Verify your basic eligibility before applying.

Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English must be passed in 10+2 or PUC (Science stream).

The minimum aggregate is typically 50% for general category and 45% for SC/ST (see the most recent brochure for precise percentages). Usually, the minimum age requirement is 18 on or before December 31 of the year of entry.

2) Choose the category in which you would apply.

Karnataka Domicile Candidate : For government and government-quota seats in private colleges, apply through KEA or state counseling.

Students can apply through KEA for up to 60% of private seats in private colleges, followed by government seats for 20% and management seats for the remaining 20%, for a total of 100% of the college's seat matrix.

If you live in a state other than Karnataka, you might be qualified for managerial, NRI, or institutional seats in private colleges. Following KEA rounds, a few vacant seats might also be filled at the institutional level. See the section below titled "Other-state students."

Colleges issue guidelines for NRI and overseas seats, which have their own category and cost schedule.

3) Entrance exam:

KEA, UGCET, or KCET (as announced). Karnataka employs its KEA portal and UGCET/KCET framework for admission to the B.P.T program (see the information bulletin for the current year for the exact exam name and dates). The details are posted on the KEA website along with the dates for online applications and counseling.

4) Register and apply (online) -

Create an account or register on KEA's official website: cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea.

Complete the online registration form carefully.

Pay the application fee (per category) and provide the necessary information (academic, contact, domicile, etc.).

Upload the following Documents (scanned): 10th and 12th grade mark sheets, transfer/caste/domicile certificates (if applicable), passport photo, signature, PUC/board passing certificate, and so forth. The brochure includes exact documents.

5) Document verification (as scheduled).

Attend online or physical verification as directed. This process validates documents and category claims. Keep originals ready for verification (10th/12th grade, DOB, SC/ST/OBC certificate, Domicile/NCC/PH if applicable).

College selection is done through the KEA Student Portal.

7) Counselling, choice filling, and seat allocation (by KEA).

After verification, log in to KEA and fill out your course and college preferences (order important).

Seat allocation: KEA announces allotment results (round-wise). Seats are distributed based on merit, reservation restrictions, and a seat matrix. Accept your seat online and follow the reporting requirements.

For example, if you secure a place at your selected college, select number 1.

Number 2: If you do not receive your selected college in the first round, you can choose choice number 2 to participate in the second round.

8) Seat category and quota distribution.

Government (State) seats are filled in government Physiotherapy colleges through KEA counselling.

Government-quota seats in private colleges: A part of private college seats are filled through state counselling.

For actual percentages and reserved categories, go to the current year's KEA information brochure/seat matrix.

9) Report to the allotted college (after allotment)

Download the allotment note from KEA (<https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in>). Pay the college or acceptance fee (as specified).

Report physically (or by online upload) to the designated college by the deadline with original documentation for final admission and joining procedures. RGUHS mandates institutions to upload admitted student information to the university site.

If the candidate does not report to the specified college by the deadline, the seat will be automatically cancelled. After the cancellation of the seat from KEA in selected college, the candidate will not have the option to his/her favorite college; thus, the candidate must take the seat picked by KEA (in any college in Karnataka).
